Latvian Minister of Health Ms. Ingrida Circene and Lithuanian Minister of Health Mr. Raimondas Šukys attended the first World Health Organization (WHO) European Conference on the new European Policy for Health “HEALTH 2020 – Working together across sector for health and well-being”.

This conference was an important milestone in the process of developing the Health 2020 policy that would be presented for adoption by the WHO Regional Committee for Europe at its 62nd session, to be held in Malta in September, 2012.

The conference was hosted by the Government of Israel. Its aim was to explore how a whole-of-government and whole-of-society approach can further improve health and well-being, and to review and identify ways to establish or consolidate dialogue with critical stakeholders across sectors and all levels of government for Health 2020. This conference provided insights into how to strengthen the leadership role of ministries of health in engaging and cooperating with other sectors and levels of government.

Summary of OECD 2011 Economic Review of Israel

The report by the Economic and Development Review Committee (EDRC) of the Organization for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD) has provided focus-areas where further responsiveness is desirable, and scenarios where Israel has and continues to display economic resilience.

Please find below some of recommendations provided by the OECD EDRC in the 2011 Report:

- Israel's recent exploration of natural gas has provided for future increased revenues, and according to the report, "Furthermore, there have been substantial new finds of offshore natural gas, which will strengthen the fiscal position, further decrease dependence in imported fuels and improve options regarding energy security". Legislation is welcomed in order to setup a sovereign wealth fund.
- Israel's GDP increased by 4.8% in 2010 and investments are growing strongly, though the report gives top priority to Israel's high public debt, which is recommended to be reduced by more than 15% by 2020.
- The review suggests a stronger policy commitment towards a market-based approach in the electricity sector, reforming the Israel Electricity Corporation. As noted, "plans are also being implemented that aim to raise the contribution of renewable electricity generation to 10% of aggregate supply, principally through thermo-solar, photovoltaic and wind power."
- The unemployment rate was noted as being the lowest point reached in history, at 5.5% in the second quarter of 2011. The participation rate was also noted as having implications to grow. Though due to recent global developments, there is a chance that these dynamics will be at risk in the near future.

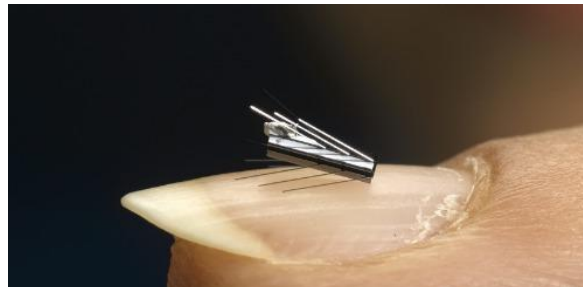

Financing Agreement Signed to Build Ashdod Desalination Plant.
The plant will produce 100 cubic meters of water annually.

In the presence of the Minister of Finance, **Dr. Yuval Steinitz**, and the Minister of National Infrastructures, **Dr. Uzi Landau**, the Accountant General in the Ministry of Finance, **Ms. Michal Abadi Boiangiu**, and the Deputy Accountant General, **Mr. Gil Shabtai**, signed a concession agreement with ADL Ltd. to design, build and operate a seawater desalination plant in the town of Ashdod. ADL, a subsidiary of Mekorot Development and Initiatives Ltd., will build and operate the plant for a period of 25 years. Project funding is being provided jointly by Hapoalim Bank and the European Investment Bank.

Based on reverse osmosis technology, the Ashdod desalination plant will supply 100 cubic meters of water annually from the end of 2013, **equivalent to 15% of Israel's total domestic water consumption**. This is the 5th desalination plant to be built in Israel, after plants in Ashkelon, Palmachim, Hadera, and the Soreq plant destined to start supplying water in 2013. **All 5 plants combined are expected to produce 85% of total domestic consumption as of 2013.**

Communications Giant Arris Group Buys Israel's BigBand Networks for \$158 mln.

ARRIS, headquartered in Suwanee, Georgia, USA, specializes in the design, engineering and supply of technology supporting triple- and quad-play broadband services for residential and business customers around the world.

US-Israeli R&D Foundation to Invest in \$8 mln in 9 New Projects.

The Israel-U.S. bi-national Industrial Research and Development (BIRD) Foundation, approved \$8.1 million of funding for 9 new projects between Israeli and American companies. The approved projects involve innovations in the areas of life sciences, healthcare IT, electronics, software and energy.

In addition to the grants from BIRD, the projects will access private sector funding, boosting the total value of all projects to \$24 million.

The BIRD Foundation promotes cooperation between Israeli and American companies in various technological fields for the purpose of joint product development. During its 34 years, the BIRD Foundation has invested in more than 820 projects, which have yielded direct and indirect revenues of about \$8 billion.

Israeli start-up Waze draws investment from Chinese billionaire.

Israeli navigation tech start-up Waze raised a \$30 million investment from Hong Kong's Li Ka-shing, greater China's richest man.

Waze's free mobile application provides a social network where drivers interact, reporting on road conditions. Its goal is to shepherd drivers by optimal routes to their destination by voice and offer data on traffic conditions, as supplied by users.

Waze, which was founded in 2008, has more than 7 million users in the U.S., Italy, France, Spain and Israel.

Li, who invests in Israeli companies through his investments' arm Horizons Ventures, earlier invested in Israeli video-editing startup Magisto.

Israeli Air Force Technology Helps Improve Sport Performance

Israel's Applied Cognitive Engineering Ltd (ACE), which specializes in computer-based cognitive simulation training, and USA Hockey, the national governing body for the sport of ice hockey in the U.S., have created a ground-breaking product called Hockey IntelliGym that helps players develop perception and decision-making skills.

The technology used for developing the Hockey IntelliGym was initially developed to train Israeli combat pilots on the cognitive brain level.

The program utilizes a software-based training environment containing automatic customization algorithms that adjusts the training program to each individual player according to his/her personal strengths, weaknesses and progress rate.

The program recorded an increase of 20% to 40% in players' actual on-court/ice stats. Since its adoption 3 different IntelliGym-trained National teams participated in a total of 12 international tournaments, including 3 world championships, out of which they have won an unprecedented 9 gold medals.

The IntelliGym has been granted with the first ever Brain Fitness Innovation Award, reviewing 40 implementations in that area.

Medigus Raises \$2.5 mln for World's Smallest Medical Camera

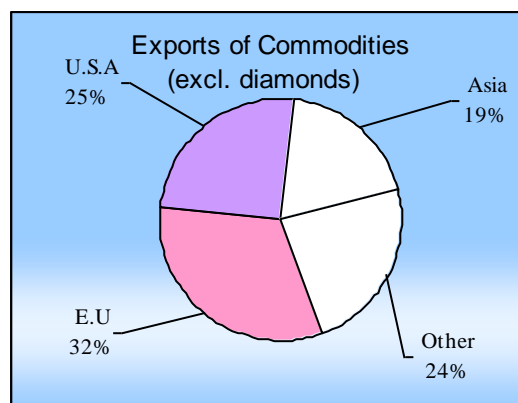
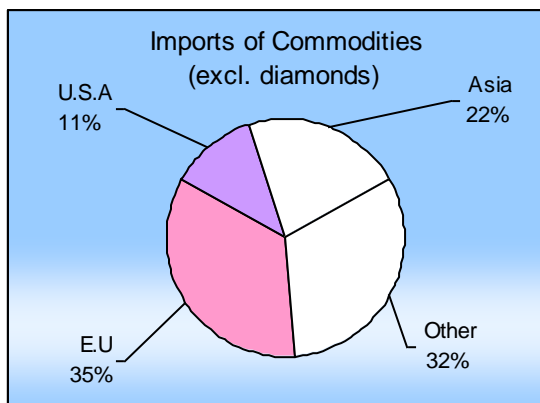
Israel's Medigus has raised \$2.5 million in order to progress with regulatory approvals for its medical procedure video camera. At 0.99 mm in diameter, the camera is the world's smallest video camera.

The miniature cameras are designed specifically for small-diameter disposable endoscopic devices, and are used in various medical fields including: cardiology, orthopedics, gastroenterology, gynecology, otolaryngology, bronchoscopy and robotic surgery.
